

31 October - 02 November 2023

andBeyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge

Ngorongoro Crater, Tanzania

Perched on the edge of the Crater rim, and Beyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge's sumptuous safari suites present breath-taking views. Inspired in design by the Maasai mud and stick manyatta (homestead), this is without doubt one of the most architecturally spectacular safari lodges in Africa. Three separate and intimate camps are reminiscent of a bygone era totalling just 30 suites in all. Steeped in romance, each stilted, handcrafted mud and thatch suite is adorned with graceful antiques and grand chandeliers. The bedroom, sitting room and ensuite bathroom boast floor-to-ceiling glass windows, overlooking the magnificent Crater below. Ensuite bathrooms, with a centerpiece of red roses, feature huge showers and chandelier-lit bathtubs. Personal butlers discreetly tend to guests' every need, bringing tea in bed, stoking fireplaces and drawing luxurious baths. Described as "Maasai meets Versailles", each camp has its own guest sitting and dining areas and viewing decks. The domed dining room, with its grand fireplace, turns every meal into a special occasion.

Spend an afternoon learning how to create beautiful Maasai beadwork with Papai, one of our Maasai Mamas.

02 - 04 November 2023

andBeyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge Lake Manyara National Park, Tanzania

Day 6: Thursday, 02 November 2023

You will be met by a member of our andBeyond team who will drive you, and fellow guests, from andBeyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge to Manyara Airstrip (Approximately 1.5 hours)

A member from our andBeyond team will meet you and fellow guests, for your road transfer from Manyara airstrip to andBeyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge. Lake Manyara National Park offers a wilderness experience in diverse habitats, from its Rift Valley soda lake to dense woodlands and steep mountainsides. Apart from a spectacular setting, the park is famous for its unusual tree-climbing lions and the vast elephant herds it was established to protect. (Approximately 3.5 hours).

Marvel at nature's beauty during your 2 night stay at andBeyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge in an elegant Stilted Treehouse with ensuite bathroom with bath, outdoor shower and viewing deck. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, scheduled safari activities, refreshments on game drives.









02 - 04 November 2023

andBeyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge

Lake Manyara National Park, Tanzania

Set in the heart of a mahogany forest, and Beyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge is the only lodge in Lake Manyara National Park. The Lodge, which was designed to exert minimal impact on the environment, is situated in the remote southwestern region of the Park. Cradled in the boughs of ancient mahogany trees, ten stilted treehouse suites are a sophisticated blend of intimacy and romance, offering privacy and exclusivity. Each treehouse suite features generous decks suspended above the forest floor and large windows to invite the lush forest inside. The bathrooms have freestanding baths with a forest view and an outdoor shower. Overlooking a forest boma (outdoor dining area), guest areas are characterised by soaring spaces. An interactive kitchen allows guests to observe the preparation of delicious Pan African food that is enjoyed in the boma, on dining decks or on private viewing decks. Breakfasts and picnics are also served on the lakeshore.

WHAT WE LOVE ABOUT ANDBEYOND LAKE MANYARA TREE LODGE

Before entering Lake Manyara National Park, be sure to stop at the Rift Valley viewpoint. Here, you can enjoy a pictureperfect view of Lake Manyara and the surrounding escarpment.

Ask your guide to take you to the Maji Moto springs (Maji Moto means 'hot water' in Kiswahili). These hot water springs are a unique geological feature found nowhere else in Tanzania, and it is said that the water will boil an egg in 30 minutes!

Experience the unique culture and fascinating way of life of the Maasai people.









04 - 06 November 2023

andBeyond Mnemba Island Lodge *Mnemba Island, Tanzania*

Day 8: Saturday, 04 November 2023

You will be transferred to the airstrip for your Coastal Aviation flight from Manyara Airstrip to Zanzibar Airport departs at 11:25 and arrives at 14:20. Zanzibar is an island steeped in culture and history - a destination which brought adventurers, seafarers and traders from far and wide.

You will be met at Zanzibar Airport by a member of our andBeyond team and driven to the Mnemba crossing point (approximately 1 hour) to meet your onward boat transfer to Mnemba Island (approximately 25 minutes). (The arrival and departure point on Mnemba does not have a jetty, so guests have to wade through shallow water and are therefore advised to dress accordingly).

Be spoilt at andBeyond Mnemba Island during your 2 night stay in a Zanzibari Banda with ensuite bathroom with shower only. Your stay includes three meals daily, soft drinks, house wines, local brand spirits and beers, teas and coffees, scuba diving - 2 dives per day - full PADI certification required, snorkelling, sunset dhow cruise, kayaking and stand-up paddle boarding.



04 - 06 November 2023

andBeyond Mnemba Island Lodge

Mnemba Island, Tanzania

andBeyond Mnemba Island offers a sheer unpretentious paradise - just ten rustic palm-frond bandas sit nestled in a tropical casuarina pine forest fringed by a white coral sand beach. Cooling ocean breezes waft in through glass-free windows that are open to the elements. A covered walkway leads to a shuttered ensuite bathroom with huge glass beaded shower. Built-in barazas on the veranda are perfect for afternoon siestas and private beach salas feature traditional Zanzibari loungers for languid hours on the beachfront. Thatched dining and sitting / bar areas have beautiful open views of the beach. Baskets of fresh fruit, fish, lobsters, crabs and prawns are sailed into Mnemba daily on traditional ngalawa outriggers. Romantic candlelit dinners are served on the beach with the waves gently lapping at one's feet. Private beach dinners delight newlyweds and not-so newlyweds alike.

WHAT WE LOVE ABOUT ANDBEYOND MNEMBA ISLAND

One lazy afternoon, ask one of the staff members to teach you how to play Mbao - a traditional wooden board game.

During a full or new moon, be sure to take a walk along the beach at low tide, when the whole atoll is exposed.

Watch turtles lay their eggs on Mnemba's sandy shores. This happens year round, however, the laying season peaks between January and August and hatchings take place approximately two months later. This is a definite must-see!



INSURANCE

It is essential that adequate travel insurance be taken out prior to departure and it is recommended that you purchase it within 14 days from paying your deposit. This should cover any medical situation such as hospitalisation, as well as cancellation, curtailment of arrangements and baggage. When you travel with andBeyond, you are automatically covered by our emergency evacuation insurance. This guarantees emergency evacuation to the nearest hospital should you suffer either severe illness or injury. This does not cover the cost of treatment once in hospital and in no way replaces your normal travel insurance. There are certain medical exclusions. Please advise us of any existing conditions in advance in order to arrange cover, subject to our insurer's approval. Please contact us for further details.

It is important to note that some travel insurance policies may not be recognized by certain local hospitals, therefore please check with your provider if their product is accepted in your destination and seek alternative cover if necessary.

LANGUAGE

The national language in Tanzania is Swahili, although English is widely spoken.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Bring sufficient memory cards and batteries as these are not always readily available. Remember to ask permission before taking a photograph of any local resident.

The use of Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (Drones) is not allowed in any of the conservation areas we manage, until such time as their impact on wildlife and anti-poaching initiatives can be assessed. This rule applies throughout Africa, as our partners have adopted a similar stance.

MONEY

Due to licencing and other issues, the Government of Tanzania has closed most of its Bureau de Change in Arusha. Due to this, acquiring foreign currency is incredibly limited. Travellers are advised to exchange foreign currency at Kilimanjaro International Airport as it is becoming more challenging in Arusha and other major towns. Most hotels and lodges accept Visa and MasterCard. In addition to credit cards, travellers should bring USD cash, as this is widely accepted. However, notes dated before 2012 are no longer accepted. Small denominations are recommended as high denomination notes may not be accepted or change may not be available. Credit card transactions could take anything up to a few months to go through, especially from more remote areas.

CLIMATE

Hot and humid on the coast, the islands, Ruaha and Selous; temperate inland; warmest period is September, October and January and the coolest is June & July. July and August can be very cold on the rim of Ngorongoro Crater. Rainfall months are in March, April, May and November; generally temperatures are pleasant ranging between 15°C (59°F) - 26°C (78°F) during the day; sometimes rising above 30°C (86°F) in the warmer months.

DIETARY

Most dietary requirements can be catered for. Please advise us of any specific dietary requirements and these will be communicated to all properties. Kosher meals are not available. and beyond Mnemba Island lodge serves fresh fish daily please advise if you would prefer to eat meat/chicken.

WHAT TO PACK

As a general guide, comfortable, casual wash and wear clothes are recommended. Muted colours are recommended for game-viewing. Game-drives are conducted in the early morning and late afternoon, which can be very cold, especially in winter. The most practical items to pack for safari are:

- Khaki, green, beige and neutral colours (dark blue and black should be avoided, as it attracts tsetse flies)
- Shirts with long sleeves (even in summer, as protection from the sun, mosquitoes and tsetse flies)
- T-shirts
- Shorts or a light skirt
- Jeans or safari trousers for evenings and cooler days
- A jacket and sweater are recommended for early morning and evening game drives
- Lightweight water-proof jacket
- Swim and beachwear
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sun block, sunglasses, hat, moisturizer and lip-salve are all essentials
- Strong insect repellent like Mozzie Guard (<u>www.mosi-guard.com</u>)
- Binoculars and camera equipment

Laundry

Most lodges, camps and hotels do their best to deliver a same day laundry service, weather permitting. Dry cleaning can be arranged at most hotels but is not available at lodges. At the lodges soap suds are generally provided in your room for delicate items. Please be mindful that, due to culture and customs in many of the areas in which we operate, some lodges/camps do not wash underwear. While most lodges/camps can arrange for your shoes to be polished, we regret that we are unable to provide a service for these to be washed.

First Aid

Although most hotels and lodges are equipped with a first aid kit, we suggest that you bring a small airtight container with a few well-chosen articles, such as plasters, travel sickness tablets, antiseptic cream, pain relieving tablets for headaches, indigestion tablets, sunscreen, eye drops, insect repellent, medication for upset stomachs and after-sun moisturiser. We remind travellers who have any allergies, e.g. insect stings, or an asthma condition, to pack the required medication.

ELECTRICITY

220/240 volts AC, 50Hz. It is possible that lodges in more remote areas do not have electricity and run on generator or solar power.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

In light of COVID-19 please note the following general safety requirements.

- All guests are advised to bring a cloth mask in the event that they country they are visiting requires a mask to be worn.
- Frequently sanitize or wash hands with soap and water as often as is possible.

- Always observe social distancing protocols and keep 1,5m (4ft) to 2m (6ft) away from other people.
- Should any visitor exhibit symptoms, or they have a temperature above 37.3°C / 99.14°F, or where medical services suspect they have COVID-19, those guests may be required to isolate in their room and may not be allowed to join scheduled activities until the results of the COVID-19 test is received.
- In the event the guest tests positive for COVID-19, they may be required to be quarantined according to country regulations at their own cost.
- Should your destination require a QR code verification of your vaccination documents or negative PCR test, please make use of a verification site. Examples of such sites include VaxYes and Clear Healthpass.

COVID-19 regulations for Tanzania and Zanzibar

In addition to all current entry requirements, the latest arrival information provided by the Tanzanian government officials is as follows:

- All travellers entering or transiting Tanzania through land, sea or airport borders are advised to be fully vaccinated as per approved schedule of primary vaccination against COVID-19 in their respective countries
- Guests are not required to present a COVID-19 vaccination certificate or RT-PCR certificate or perform a Rapid Antigen test, but we have received reports of officials asking for said documents on arrival
- We therefore recommend that guests travel with their vaccination certificate or RT-PCR certificate to avoid unnecessary hassle
- Thermal and physical screening will be done on arrival, and random Rapid Antigen tests may be administered by airport officials free of charge
- All departing guests are advised to seek information prior to departure regarding COVID-19 requirements of their country
 of destination or conveyance to be used

Yellow Fever:

andBeyond's Terms and Conditions require you to obtain advice from your medical practitioner or travel clinic before traveling to any destination to determine if you are required to get a yellow fever vaccination, no less than 10 days prior to travel. If required, you must be able to produce a yellow fever certificate as proof of vaccination. Depending on which countries you are traveling to pre or post your stay in Kenya and Tanzania the certificate will be required. The certificate may also be required when re-entering your country of origin, or other African countries, if you have visited a destination within the yellow fever belt. For more information you may consult the following website, but we must reiterate that we advise you to visit your medical practitioner or your closest travel clinic for further information.

It is not generally a requirement to have the yellow fever vaccination to visit Kenya, but one may be required for onward travel or return home, as Kenya falls within a Yellow Fever area. An exception for arrivals is visitors coming to Kenya from another country where the risk of transmitting yellow fever is high. All travellers over the age of 9 months are required to have the yellow fever vaccination if they have:

- Recently visited a high-risk country
- Spent over 12 hours in transit in a high-risk country

andBeyond recommends that travellers entering East Africa, even from non-endemic countries, receive a vaccination in their home country prior to travel as a precautionary measure. Yellow fever regulations can be complex when moving between countries and regions in East Africa. Health and immigrations officials can be inconsistent in enforcing the regulations. When they do, and travellers do not have the required documentation, it can result in refusal of entry and unnecessary delays.

Additionally, it is essential for those travelling from Kenya to Tanzania to obtain a yellow fever certificate. Tanzanian health officials have held guests at the border for extended periods of time due to lack of certificates. Failure to provide a yellow fever certificate at these specific points may result in refusal of entry.

If guests cannot have a yellow fever vaccination for medical reasons a doctors letter needs to be provided; signed, stamped and on an official letterhead.

Ticks:

Ticks can be found in Africa's wilderness areas. To avoid getting bitten when going on bush walks, guests are advised to take precautions by wearing long trousers, socks and boots. Please note that there is a possibility that tick bites could lead to tick bite fever. Symptoms include fever, headaches and painful, enlarged lymph glands in the area of the bite. If you experience these symptoms after returning home, please visit your doctor and advise them of the possibility of tick bite fever.

Allergies, Medication and Prescriptions:

If you suffer allergies, it is advised to take counteracting medication with you, as the medication you require may not be available due to the remoteness of these destinations.

If you are on medication at the time of travel please ensure that you bring a sufficient supply for the entire trip, as it may be difficult to obtain after arrival. This applies to any malaria prophylaxis, prescriptions, chronic or preferred brand medication.

Your itinerary may include accommodation services at properties (i.e. Accommodation at non andBeyond branded lodges and /or camps) and / or ancillary services such as transfers, tours, and activities that will not be provided by andBeyond but by independent third party owners and / or operators that are not owned and / or managed by andBeyond ("Third Party Service Providers"). Whilst all Third Party Service Providers of andBeyond have committed to implement similar processes and procedures as to our Infectious Diseases: Health and Safety Protocol to try and protect guests making use of their services, andBeyond is not in a position to validate or dictate their health and safety protocols which will vary between Third Party Service Providers. As a result we cannot confirm the standard to which Third Party Service Providers protocols adhere to and as such we cannot accept any form of liability (in the broadest terms) should you (or any member of your party) contract an infectious disease (including covid-19) when using the services of a Third Party Service Provider. TANZANIA

FLIGHTS & TRANSFERS

Check-in is 1hr prior for domestic departures and 2hrs prior for international departures.

Scheduled regional and inter-lodge flights may involve multiple stops before reaching the final destination. Flights are operated as "shuttle transfers" and therefore departure times may vary up to 1hr. Times are subject to change without notice.

In the event of bad weather, airlines reserve the right to drop guests off at the nearest serviceable airstrip which may mean a road transfer for guests to get to their final destination. Any costs resulting from such diversions would be for your own account. Aircraft used on inter-lodge flights are small and interior space limited. In addition, some activity and scenic air operators may also have weight and/or height restrictions. For the sake of your own comfort, please advise us at time of booking if you are particularly bulky or tall and we will do our best to accommodate you. Additional costs may apply.

Flights from the Serengeti National Park or Lake Manyara region, to Arusha, might route via Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) before stopping in Arusha. This usually occurs if this is the aircraft's last flight of the day.

Weather conditions at Ngorongoro Crater usually prevent direct flights by private charter to the Crater Airstrip for the majority of airlines. Please be aware that guests will land at Manyara Airstrip and be transferred to and Beyond Ngorongoro Crater Lodge by road. This is a journey of up to 2hrs and is at an additional cost. NCAA (Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authority) gate times are from 06h00 to 18h00 which means that transfer vehicles are only allowed to leave Ngorongoro Crater Lodge from 06h00. Please keep this in mind for onward connecting transfer and flight arrangements.

andBeyond cannot be held responsible should airlines discontinue flights or change scheduled times resulting in missed connections etc. Should an amendment in a routing or itinerary be necessary, we will re-quote accordingly.

TRANSFERS

Manyara Airstrip to andBeyond Lake Manyara Tree Lodge: a scenic three-and-a-half-hour drive to the Lodge through the national park, with game viewing en route.

Lobo Airstrip to andBeyond Klein's Camp: a leisurely one-and-a-half-hour drive to camp, with game viewing en route.

&Beyond Mnemba Island transfer guidelines: After dark, both boat and road conditions are unsafe, so please take note of the following important transfer guidelines:

Morning departure from the Island for the 08h30 or 09h00 domestic flight and 11h00 International flight:

- Summer morning departure time: 06h00
- Winter morning departure time: 06h30

Afternoon flight arrival at Zanzibar Airport:

- Latest flight arrival at airport 15h30 for them to be transferred latest at 16h00
- For any late arrivals that fall outside this cut-off time, you will need to overnight in Stone Town for the safety reasons noted above.

Please be aware that there is a boat transfer to and Beyond Mnemba. As neither the departure point on Zanzibar, nor the arrival point on Mnemba has a jetty, guests have to wade through shallow water and are therefore advised to dress accordingly.

Game drives into the Ngorongoro Crater - Game drives usually take place from 06h00 to 17h00. The descent road into the Crater closes at 16h00. Due to the drive down into the Crater most guests elect to do one game drive rather than two in a day, allowing them themselves time to rest and enjoy the views from the Lodge.

Viewing the Great Migration in the Serengeti - For guests staying at andBeyond Serengeti Under Canvas/andBeyond Klein's Camp/andBeyond Grumeti, please note that there may be some distance to cover to view the migration. The migration regrettably cannot be guaranteed but the guides will do their utmost to find it. In discussion with the guide and others on the vehicle there is the option to head out for a full day game drive with packed lunch if it proves necessary.

Scuba Diving at Mnemba Island - For scuba diving at andBeyond Mnemba, all divers must provide proof that they hold a valid diving certificate. If not, diving courses are available at an additional cost.

LUGGAGE ALLOWANCE

As you will be travelling in vehicles and aircraft with limited space, luggage is required to be packed in a soft bag weighing a maximum of 15kg (33 lbs) which includes hand luggage and camera equipment.

Type of luggage & dimensions: Soft bags with maximum dimensions of 35cm (13.7 inches) wide x 40 cm (15.7 inches) high and 70 cm (27.5 inches) long. No hard suitcases are allowed, and oversized bags may not be carried on your lap. An additional seat can be booked for extra luggage, subject to availability.

Airline luggage requirements will vary slightly between airlines - some will allow rigid frames or wheels according to strict internal guidelines. We recommend soft bags with correct dimensions as a default but can provide specific and up-to-date luggage rules on request. These rules are often updated without notification so are best checked nearer departure.

When travelling to any of our destinations in Africa, please remember that possession of wildlife trophies is illegal. A wildlife trophy is defined as "any protected animal, game animal, or game bird, alive or dead and any bone, claw, egg, feather, hair, hoof, skin, tooth, tusk or other durable portion whatsoever of that animal or bird or fish or other aquatic life whether processed, added to or changed by the work of man or not, which is recognizable as such a durable portion". Any person found in possession of these restricted items, without the necessary permits, will be liable to a fine and/or prison term, with the said item being confiscated. In Kenya, certain items made from the ostrich and crocodile skin, both of which are being reared for the purpose, would be permitted as proper permits are issued by the dealers.

Plastic Bags Banned in Kenya and Tanzania

Kenya and Tanzania join over 40 countries that have made plastic bags illegal, in a positive effort to reduce the impact on our environment. The ban applies to carrier bags with handles (and with or without gussets), and flat bags without handles and without gussets.

If you are travelling to Kenya and Tanzania, plastic bags that match the above description, including duty free bags, will be confiscated at the airport. However, there is a bigger risk that if anyone is caught using these plastic bags, the fine is KSh4 000 000 (approximately USD 38 000) or a prison sentence of up to four years. If you are travelling to these countries, please refrain from using all forms of 'disposable' plastic bags in both main luggage and hand luggage, to avoid inconveniences and possible prosecution.

While we are aware that certain countries require carry on liquids to be packaged in clear bags for security reasons, we recommend purchasing a clear, non-disposable toiletry bag, as an alternative to zip-lock bags, when travelling to Kenya and Tanzania.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

For assistance with visa information and/or application we have retained the services of a specialist visa service. Please visit https://apply.joinsherpa.com/explore/ZAF?affiliateId=andbeyondevisa&language=en-US

Passports are required by all foreign visitors and must be valid for six months after the intended length of stay. Please ensure that you have at least two consecutive blank visa pages (not endorsement pages) in your passport. Our recommendation is three or even four blank pages if you are travelling through more than one country. If there is insufficient space in the passport then entry could be denied.

Visa costs and requirements are specific to nationality and country of origin. It is imperative to check your visa requirements with the relevant embassies / consulates as it may vary according to your nationality.

Requirements and costs for visas can change with little notice. The official source for up-to-date visa requirements can be found by following the links by country below. Where it is possible to obtain an electronic visa, we recommend doing so.

Eligibility for visa on arrival is indicated on the official websites. On occasion it may prove more convenient to make use of an intermediary to obtain a visa. These services are tailored to the language and market they serve and are available online.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON ARRIVAL

The time taken to clear immigration and customs will vary based on your arrival time. Guests can book an andBeyond representative to meet them on arrival and assist with formalities before escorting them to their transfer. At the discretion of airport authorities, pre-arranged VIP meet and greet services at certain airports can meet arrivals airside and escort them through expedited formalities.

TANZANIA

The primary gateway for Tanzania is Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) commonly referred to as Kilimanjaro. As of August 2019, JRO has changed its process of issuing visas on arrival. Guests needing visas will be required to go through a 5-step process that is estimated to take up to two hours. This is only applicable to guests arriving at Kilimanjaro without a visa. We do recommend applying for a Tanzanian e-visa before you travel, as having one can speed up the immigrations process.

Costs for visa on arrival are payable in US dollars. The major credit cards are accepted but networks are often down, therfore cash is recommended, small denominations of bills not older than 2012 as officials are not in the position to give change. While our ground handling team will support our guests through the process it is recommended that all guests needing visas apply for them before arrival in Tanzania.

CROSSING BORDERS BY ROAD - WHAT TO EXPECT

There may be instances where immigration formalities need to be completed at a road border post rather than an airport customs desk. One such is the crossing between Kenya and Tanzania using the Migori-Tarime route, a combination of light aircraft flights and a road transfer through the border post.

Guests are required to present themselves at immigration in the following sequence:

- Light aircraft flight will arrive at Migori (Kenya) or Tarime (Tanzania) depending which direction guest is travelling
- A vehicle will await guests at the airstrip for a transfer to the border an airline representative on the vehicle will explain the immigration procedures
- If traveling from Kenya to Tanzania, the border is called Sirari on the Kenyan side.
- If traveling from Tanzania to Kenya the border is called Isibania on the Tanzanian side.
- · When applying for online visas these please note this is a land crossing, and use the applicable entry point above
- On arrival at Sirari/Isebania border post Kenya/Tanzania health officials will check if guests have yellow fever certificates
- If cleared, they proceed to the Kenya/ Tanzania immigration counter and fill in the exit forms
- Present the form, passport, and yellow fever certificate to immigration officials at the counter
- Once stamped, walk across to the Kenya/Tanzania immigration counter
- · Health officials will check the yellow fever certificate and give the go ahead to proceed to the immigration counter
- Fill in entry forms
- · Hand over documentation to immigration officials
- · Once cleared, walk out of the office
- The transfer vehicle will be positioned at the parking bay just a short walking distance from the building less than three minutes
- Please note bags may be scanned and/or checked by custom officials
- Important note never carry any animal trophies, even if legally acquired (these include ostrich eggs)
- If you are in need of foreign currency only exchange at a Forex Bureau or bank
